As Senator, I have done just that – authoring 46 bills signed into law – including strengthening climate goals; improving fire prevention efforts; increasing sea level rise planning; and requiring more efficient state buildings. As Education Budget Subcommittee Chair, a substantial increase in public education funding was approved. I fought for higher education student housing, resulting in 624 units for the district. I achieved restoration of UC's Cooperative Agriculture Extension – helping small farmers with needed science and technical help. 9

I was a leader in saving Watsonville Hospital. I helped get Santa Cruz support that contributed to a reduction in unhoused people. I negotiated the future footprint of the Coastal Trail through Big Sur, and created a path to preserve Diablo Canyon lands. When atmospheric rivers hit the Central Coast, I secured support for communities in Santa Cruz, Monterey, and San Luis Obispo Counties, as well as for evacuated residents who needed help. - 14
